**37.** <sup>1</sup>The hand of the LORD was on me, and He brought me out by the Spirit of the LORD and set me in the middle of a valley; it was full of bones. <sup>2</sup>He led me back and forth among them, and I saw a great many bones on the floor of the valley, bones that were very dry. <sup>3</sup>He asked me, "Son of man, can these bones live?"

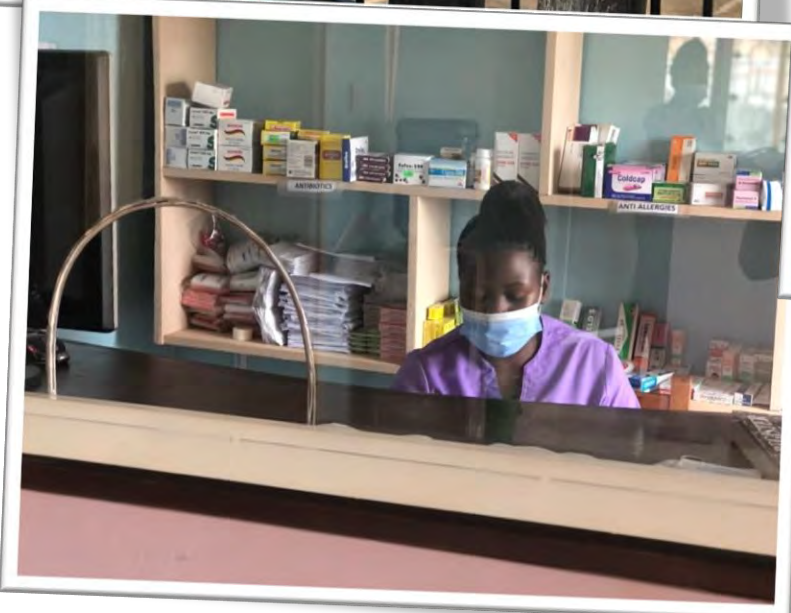




**Launch of YESU AKWAGALA Medical Center – Seguku.**

February 1<sup>st</sup>, was the launch and start of operations of the YESU AKWAGALA Medical Center, a Grade III rated Health Unit as per the Ministry of Health classification. The center is equipped with modern medical equipment, a functioning Theater and a team of qualified medical practitioners who with care have become a blessing to our community and its environs to many who could not access medical services of the kind. Our team has carried out many life-saving operations, treating various ailments and the Lord working through them to bring healing. There is truly an open heaven over the Medical Center.

Throughout the pandemic, the Medical Center has attended to many covid-19 patients via treatment and on support of oxygen, thereby saving many who have succumbed to the disease. We thank God that the center has become a life saving – life giving place.





**YESU Akwagala Bible College – Update.**

There has been remarked progress at both; the construction of facilities at the new home of **YABC** located at **Buvi**, and of the team. On February 11<sup>th</sup>, the **Uganda Christian Outreach Ministries Board of Directors**, met with the **YABC Governing Council** and together discussed the way ahead. There was welcoming on board new members and also renewing of commitment and contracts for all the Governing Council members. Later on Monday February 15<sup>th</sup>, we together visited the new campus for inspection of the works. We are grateful to God for this direction into a new season for and at YABC and eagerly wait for when school will resume after the lock down is lifted.

In the meantime, YABC has launched **e-Learning** for the final year students. We are at almost at **80%** of the **construction works** at the new campus and hope that all will be **100%** when schools are cleared to reopen again.





APOSTOLIC Ministry – Makoomi Worship Center.

On February 19<sup>th</sup>, we ordained **Pastor Godfrey Jjuuko** as the Lead pastor for the congregation and church of **Makoomi Worship Center**. This comes after the **retirement of Pastor Robert Waiswa**, which coupled with the pandemic and lockdown, had left the entire community into the 'valley of dry bones'. On the ordination, the Holy Spirit breathed life over the community, and this was evidenced with a ground-breaking for the construction of a church building; bricks have been made, stone aggregates and sand mobilized. **APOSTOLIC Visit – KITO Worship Center**

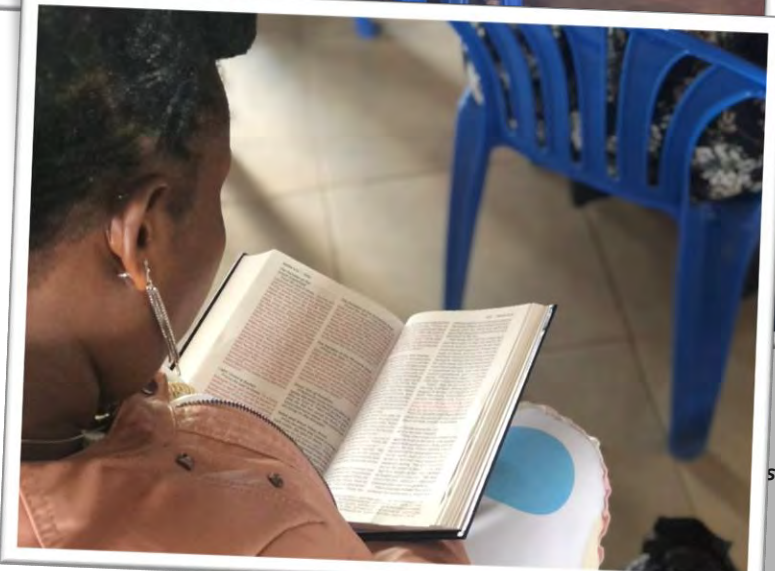
